Under the agreement, Bamburi will buy electricity from Momnai Energy, which will finance, develop, manage, operate as well as maintain the solar photovoltaic plants. Momnai energy will build the larger solar plant with 14.5 MWp capacity near Bamburi's plant in Mombasa on the Kenyan coast.

However, in the absence of a mature commercial model for energy storage, investment in power storage projects could be a huge burden to PV investors.
