

Voltage (V) - Power. Voltage is the measure of electrical potential in a battery. It determines the power output of your cordless tool. In general, higher voltage correlates with increased power and torque, which can be ...

A higher Ah battery doesn"t mean it"s better. Rather, a higher Ah means longer runtime before the battery needs to be recharged. Simply put, Ah represents the capacity of a battery, the higher the Ah, the higher the runtime. ...
